Now comes the applicant, _____, a resident of _____ County, State of _____, and does hereby give an irrevocable consent that any lawsuits or action may be commenced against said applicant in any court of competent jurisdiction in the State of Minnesota by the service on the Secretary of State by any summons, process or pleadings authorized by the laws of the State of Minnesota. It being further agreed that the service of any process or pleadings on the Secretary of State shall be taken and held in all courts to be as valid and binding as if due service had been made upon the applicant in the State of Minnesota.

In case any summons, process or pleadings are served upon the Secretary of State it shall be by duplicate copies. One of which shall be retained in the offices of the Secretary of State, and the other forwarded immediately by registered mail to the address of the applicant as shown by the records of the Secretary of State, against whom the summons, process or pleading may be divested.
