

Property and Medications

All property that an inmate arrives to the facility with, or in possession of, will remain in custody of the Mower County Jail until the inmate's release with the exception of:

- ✓ Within the first 48 hours of an inmate's detention, they may release keys for a vehicle and/or apartment or house.
- ✓ If an inmate is in possession of another person's property (EBT card, Credit card, Debit card, etc.) and it can be verified with a form of government issued identification, the Mower County Jail may release this at any time.

Property release: A "Property Release Form" will be filled out with the inmate and Jail Staff. After it has been completed, Jail Staff will verify the identity of the person the property is being released to. The person receiving the property release MUST have a form of government issued identification.

Medications: For inmates who have prescription medication that is used daily, it must be dropped off at the facility within 24 hours from the time of arrest. For medications received after 24 hours, they will be denied entry into the facility. After the 24 hours has passed, the Jail Medical Staff will complete all medication orders for the inmate.

**Medications that are not in their original container, that are expired, and/or not taken in accordance with their directions will be denied.*
